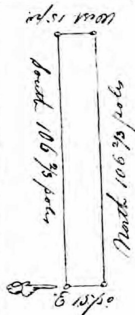

By virtue of entry N. 14764 and dated the 20th day of March 1818. founded on a Certificate Warrant N. 1154 issued by the Register of West Tennessee to Edmund Jennings for 100 acres.

I have surveyed for James Simpson assignee of Edmund Jennings ten acres of lands in White County on the waters of the Caneys forks, beginning at a Black oak and white oak William Morrisons South East corner, running thence East with the line of Isaac

Taylor and James Townsends, sixty acre survey fifteen poles to a post in the line of Levi Sanderlins survey, thence North with said line one hundred six and two thirds poles to a large post oak, thence West fifteen poles to two posts oaks in the line of William Morrisons before mentioned survey, thence South with said line one hundred and six poles and two thirds to the beginning
