There is granted by the said State of Tennessee said *John M. Little*
Assignee of the said Robert Thomas
A certain tract or Parcel of Land, containing *Thirty acres* by survey
bearing date the 11th day of *July 1813* by *John M. Little*
situated in the first District, on the waters of
Jay's Creek and bounded as follows to wit: *beginning*
at a black walnut standing at the entrance
of the pond thence East crossing the road leading
from White Plains to Oak Island at forty three
poles six and fifty poles to two black oaks thence
North crossing the before mentioned road at fifty
poles in all ninety six poles to a hickory and post
oak thence west fifty poles to a black oak thence
South ninety six poles to the beginning

With the hereditaments and appurtenances. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel
of Land, with its appurtenances, to the said *John M. Little*
and his heirs forever. In witness whereof *Joseph*
Memm Governor of the State of Tennessee, hath hereunto set his hand, and caused
the great seal of the State to be affixed, at *Knoxville* on the *Twenty first* day
of *June* in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and *seventeen*
