first day of December A.D. 1782 personally appeared  
in open court before Jacob By the President  
and his Associates Judges of the Court of Common  
Pleas of Cheyler County aforesaid now com-  
posed and holding a Court of Common Pleas  
in and for said County a Court of Record  
in said Commonwealth a certain Commencer  
aged seventy eight years servant in law  
Alexander of the County of Cheyler who  
came and sworn according to Law with an  
in solemn oath make the following declara-  
tion in order to obtain the benefit of the pro-  
visions of the act of Congress aforesaid, To-wit:  
1782

That he entered the service as a Volunteer  
and served as a private Soldier under  
Captain Jacob Zimmerman and Lieutenant  
Jacob Levan both of Lancaster County, in  
the County of Berks and Commonwealth of  
Pennsylvania in his place of residence at  
the time of service. The service as aforesaid  
that he does not remember what Regiment  
he was attached to but that Peter Miller  
was their commanding Officer of the Regiment  
that he marched from Lancaster aforesaid  
about the Month of September in the year 1777  
to Lancaster now which County was then  
known to Berks in Northampton County then  
through the State of New York to Albany that he  
was not engaged in any Battle during the  
whole campaign except that of the Battle  
of Red Bank except the Delaware at Mifflin  
during the time he was stationed at the latter
