This Indenture made this sixth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eight Between David Nicholas of the County of White and State of Tennessee of the one Part, and William Lewis Jun^r of the County and State aforesaid of the other Part Witnesses: That the said David Nicholas for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and twenty dollars current money by the said William Lewis Jun^r to him in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath bargained sold and

in kind vested, by virtue of a Deed of bar-
 gain and sale, made and executed by Thomas
 de Corry to him the said David Nicholas dated
 the second day of June 1808 to one certain
 tract or parcel of land containing by estima-
 tion sixty Acres be the same more or less; bounded
 and bounded as followeth To wit: Beginning
 at two beeches below the spring corner with Ben-
 jamin Lewis, and with his line running thence
 South fourteen poles to a sugar tree, thence with
 another of his lines South fifty degrees East one
 hundred and forty seven poles to a poplar, Red
 Oak, and two dogwoods, thence leaving Lewis South
 ten degrees East West passing David McDanalds
 corner and with his line twenty five and a
 half poles to a hickory and two dogwoods, thence
 South eighty four degrees west one hundred and
 thirty seven poles to a White Oak and dogwoods
 thence North forty five degrees East sixty poles to three
 white Oaks, thence North thirty six poles to a large
 poplar and hickory, thence North thirty degrees
 west thirty six poles to a black oak, thence North
 twelve degrees East twenty six poles to a beech and
 two dogwoods, thence North three degrees East, twenty
