I dispose of the same as follows, first, I direct that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid as soon after my decease as possible out of any monies that I may die possessed of, or may first come into the hands of my executors from any portion of my estate real or personal. secondly I give and bequeath unto my dear wife Mary Farley all of my goods and chattles lands and tenements during her life time-- Third I give and bequeath unto my Seven children Obedience, Williams, Thomas, John, Jeremiah, Nancy & Stephen and at the death of my dearly beloved wife Mary Farley the whole of my property Both real and personal be it of what Kind, nature or quality Seven to be equally divided between these my above named children. I do hereby make ordain and appoint my dearly beloved Son-in-law Thomas Fallent & Jeremiah Farley my dear Son executors of this my last will and testament. In Witness whereof I Stephen Farley the said testator have to this my Will Written on one Sheet of paper set my hand and Seal this the eight of October in the year of our Lord One Thousand eight hundred and thirty Seven.
