ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING
KNOW, YE That by Virtue of part of Certificate No 2610 dated the 7th day of
March 1817 passed by the Register at West Tennessee to William Spiller for
110 Acres and more on the 19th day of ~~Nov~~ 1817

There is granted by the said state of Tennessee, unto John Allen
a certain Tract or Parcel of Land, containing Thirty Acres by survey bearing
N 40° E 1/4 of Sec 17 Twp 12 N R 10 W Dist 10th
County on the Eastern side of the Creek of the land of the said
beginning at the Creek about one pole east of
the top of the west bounding line there North bearing the
said road bearing from the party to the top of
thirty four poles to a Black Oak and
the said road bearing the the first mentioned road at forty
poles in all forty nine poles to a Black Oak and
two feet to the house and the twenty eight poles to a
small sapwood spruce nine East forty nine poles
to the beginning

With the hereditaments and appurtenances. To have and to hold the said tract or
Parcel of Land, with its appurtenances to the said John Allen
and his heirs forever. In witness whereof
Governor of the state of Tennessee, hath hereunto set his hand, & caus-
ed the great Seal of the state to be affixed, at ~~Memphis~~ on the 29th
day of ~~Nov~~ in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and nine
