 Whereas on this 27<sup>th</sup> day of March A. D. 1842 the death of William Simpson late of the County of White deceased was suggested in open Court and that he departed this life intestate, Whamison Anthony Bebout was appointed and qualified administrator of all and singular the goods and chattels, rights and Credits of the decedent. This was done for to empower the said Administrator to enter into and the same and then into his proper hands wherever the same may be found in this
